

## Free Picks – December 9th Weekend

We're coming off a **MONSTER** weekend, with our picks going 3 for 4, and with our NFL pick coming within three yards of hitting, which would have made us a perfect 4-for-4 on the weekend! We gave you underdog value with the Senators (money), picked the TWolves as slight faves on the road (bingo), and knew well in advance that Navy would cover against Army. We're coming off our first wrong NFL pick in the last four weeks, and we missed hitting it by three measly yards. In its last 18 games at home coming off a straight up win, the Cards are just 3-15 ATS. Take history, recent trends, the emotional edge, and the stats – **Play Washington.**

We love situations where bookies put too much value on a home team. That's what they've done this week with the Memphis Grizzlies, listing them as four point favorites against the Dallas Mavericks. Both teams are hot, to be sure, but we think that taking points with Dallas is never a bad thing, and at 7-3 on the road this year, we expect them to keep this one close right until the very end. Dirk Nowitzki matches up well offensively with Memphis, and is coming off a 31 point night against Indy. Dallas looked much stronger in their last win than Memphis did, and it was against actual competition, whereas the Grizzlies beat up on the Hornets. Take the "dog" on this one for the best value, and **Play Dallas.**

Our hockey fans are bound to be confident after our puckline play paid off in a big way, and this week we've got another puckline spectacular as the rested Atlanta Thrashers take on the Columbus Blue Jackets, who are coming off a rare win Thursday night. We're predicting Columbus would have a hard time putting together back-to-back wins at the best of times, but after an emotional shootout victory less than 24 hours before? Forget about it. Atlanta's scored almost twice as many goals as Columbus this season, in a much harder division.
