

Free Picks – November 25th Weekend

Hop on our NFL win streak while you can! New England and Kansas City face off in a battle of two teams with struggling defenses. Normally you might not look at such a game as a good opportunity to bet the under, but this week we have just the right situation. Linesmakers are one step ahead of you—because the general betting public is expecting this one to turn into a shootout, the line has crept up to 51, which means there is tremendous value on the under, simply because the majority of people expect this one to go way over. Don't forget, the under is 5-0 in Chiefs games when the total is 47.5 or higher, and in the last two games between these teams, the under has won the day.

The Patriots still are getting a lot of respect from bettors, but their offense has not shown us that they deserve it. The Chiefs have been consistently improving their pass defense, and the Patriots run defense has been very solid as of late. While neither team is a defensive powerhouse, their strengths on defense tend to cancel out their opponents' strengths on offense. Each team will look for to long, drawn-out offensive drives to keep the other team's offense off the field. The under is 6-2 in these teams last eight games combined. We expect a total in the 40s. **Play the Under.**

Those of you who have been subscribers for a while will know that we love betting against teams coming off a shocking win as dogs the previous week. History tells us that such teams often have a major letdown after the euphoria of their surprising victory the previous week. Georgia QB Shockley is ready to go at full strength against Georgia Tech this weekend, and will make the difference against Tech's Reggie Baul, who is simply not the player Shockley is. The Bulldogs are 14-2 SU on the road in their past 16, and will terrorize the Georgia Tech defense all day. Tech has not covered the spread in back-to-back weeks in more than TWO YEARS. We're as shocked as you are. Take the line at -4 now. Linesmakers responded to Tech's huge upset by shortening the price on Georgia, and we're taking the better team this weekend. **Play Georgia.**

Listen up hockey fans: the Pittsburgh Penguins aren't as bad as their record might lead you to believe. We've said all along that this team is just waiting to gel, and they're above .500 in their last 10. Tonight they face a WORSE Florida Panthers team who somehow is listed as the home favorites. When a dog isn't really a dog, we've got to bite. Pittsburgh: better on the road than at home so far this year. Florida: winless in their last 10, 2-5-2 against Atlantic Division teams, and yet somehow the favorite. **Play Pittsburgh**, at a juicy underdog price.

The Denver Nuggets host the surprising LA Clippers tonight, and after getting dismantled by the Detroit Pistons, things don't get any easier for the Nugs. The Clippers

have everyone around the league talking, yet are listed as underdogs, in large part due to Denver's 5-1 home record. However, Denver is just one game over .500, while the Clippers are the third best team in the NBA. They are 4-1 against Western Conference teams, (compared to Denver's 5-5), and come into tonight's game on a four-game winning streak. Look for the Clips to stay hot. A SU win wouldn't surprise us in the least, but they had trouble putting the Raptors away last game, so take the points, and **Play Los Angeles ATS.**

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
