

Free Picks – October 28th Weekend

Guys – our hockey and pro football picks EASILY cashed last week, and we're back for more with another bunch of multi-sport freebies. We're feeling confident heading into the NBA season, having broken down the numbers over the summer and uncovered some special systems, so look for our first NBA pick coming next week!

We're always interested to see home dogs, because these dogs often surprise some bettors and linesmakers too. One such situation comes this week as Buffalo hosts Ohio University, with Ohio coming off an easy 17-point victory over Ball State. The 'Cats are 3-0 at home, but have yet to win on the road, losing by more than 20 points routinely. Buffalo is coming off of two ATS wins, their defense remains solid, and the offense is beginning to come around, with 300+ yards in four of their last five. Ohio U, on the other hand, is still struggling to move up the field, passing 300 offensive yards just twice this year. Historically, Buffalo has done well at home in recent years ATS, and Ohio has yet to show us they can get the job done on the road. **Play Buffalo**, and don't be surprised if they win outright.

Detroit hosts Chicago this weekend in NFL action, and we're expecting defenses to rule the roost. Don't be intimidated by the low total—this is still a bargain, for a variety of reasons. In their last two matchups, the Bears have given up the total of three FGs, holding Baltimore to under 200 yards, and dominating play in the Ravens' end. Chicago is allowing a measly 11 points per game this year, and we're expecting to see the Lions offense thwarted at home. Detroit's defense has been good too, though, and Kyle Orton isn't exactly a huge threat. This is the same Lions team that has put up 11 picks in their last four. Historically speaking, we're looking at a trend where the Under has gone 3-1 in the last four meetings between these two teams, and we'll expect the record to go to 4-1 after Sunday. **Play the Under**.

Things are looking up in Pittsburgh as the Pens have finally broken out of their slump to start the season, putting up 7 goals in a shootout with Atlanta on Thursday. Mario Lemieux looks to be heating up, with 5 points in that game and 11 on the season. Sid Crosby has been making it look easy, with 14 points in 10 games, and we predict the Penguins win this one outright as the dog. **Play Pittsburgh**.
